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
Sub : Base line Test for Classes I to X

- * Baseline Assessment/Tests refers to a benchmark or starting point in a student's learning journey during the academic year and transition process. It helps measure progress throughout the academic session. It provides a bird's eye view as to where our children are and where they need to be. It helps student, parent and educationist to plan and monitor the teaching and learning process.
- * The objective of the baseline tests is to help build capacity and achieve high standards of achievement and attainment in core subjects- English, Mathematics and Science/EVS.
- * These baseline tests help in Target setting, Intervention /Remedial and Enrichment programmes, so that the learning needs of each and every child is met right from the beginning of an academic year.
- * Furthermore, it is the start point of a robust tracking of the evaluation system. The test helps educators identify gaps in core subjects and helps narrow the gaps.

Please be informed that IPHS is conducting the Baseline test for all the students of the classes **I to X**. The test is based on the portion/ syllabus already studied in the previous academic year. There is no preliminary preparations required for the test. There is no pass or fail criteria , its just a benchmarking to arrive at a grade .
